Parking Lot Safety

School parking lots can be incredibly busy in the morning when children arrive and in the afternoon when it's dismissal time.

Please reduce speed when entering the parking lot. If you park, you **MUST** walk your child through the parking lot. No child may walk in the parking lot unattended. If you are using the drop off lane please remember students should independently exit the vehicle, you may not park in the drop off lane. If your student needs help exiting the vehicle please park and walk your student through the parking lot.

If our staff is no-longer outside greeting students, this means the school day has begun and you must park, bring your student in and they must be signed in.
