CHILD FIND: Child Find is an on-going process of locating, identifying and evaluating children birth to age 26, who may have developmental delays or disabilities who are in need of special education and related services. All children identified with developmental delays or a specific disability are entitled to a free, appropriate public education designed to meet his/her needs.

Hartland Schools along with Livingston Educational Service Agency (LESA), engages in activities and assessments to identify children who may be suspected of having a developmental delay or disability. This includes students enrolled in private schools or are home-schooled, mobile, migrant or homeless.

Referrals for special education can be made by anyone concerned with a child's educational performance including a parent, teacher, community agency or school official.
